

Solar observation taken at the North quarter corner of Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian.





NARRATIVE


This survey was done at the request of Laura Parsons. In researching this survey, I went back to the original ownership of Thompson Addition at the time of platting. The Thompson's owned the West half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter Thompson Addition at the time of platting. The Thompson's owned the West half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 15. I establish the exterior of the Addition by the standard subdivision of the Southwest quarter of the Section from the existing monumentation of the aliquot corners of the section. Having established the exterior, I then locate the centerlines of the streets proportionately along the exterior of the Addition. I then establish the locations of the centerlines within this subdivision by proportionate measure. I then locate the individual blocks 30 feet and parallel with these centerlines. There are only three surveys done prior to this which actually fall within this Addition. Survey Numbers 1~68, 51~77 and 55~80. With the exception of survey number 55~80, they did not consider the exterior of this subdivision being an aliquot portion of Section 15. I cannot determine if the developments within this Addition are a result of the erroneous surveys, or if the surveys are a result of the acceptance of the lines of occupation rather than the title lines of the Addition. I cannot justify accepting these monuments, as they would create even more havoc within the Addition. The subdivision of this land was a simultaneous conveyance and the excess and deficiency must be equally shared in all the lots within the Addition. All lots are dimensioned on the original plat as shown, with no particular area being a remnant, even though several lines of the lots along the exterior are of odd dimension, the skew was considered at the time of platting. As shown, the lines of occupation, particularly within Block 4, are not in common with the true location of the Addition. A foundation location survey by J.G. Voelz in 1972 documents the improvements on this lot, and briefly address the encroachments as being in existence for a "Number of years" prior to 1972. The physical improvements vary in loc particular location. I have discussed the situation with all parties involved and a lot line adjustment could occur, assuming an agreement can be reached between the affected owners. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
