NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Gary Tucker. Mr. Tucker wished to locate the exterior of the property prior to a partition. This parcel is part of a string of sequential conveyances. The original owner, Frank Thomas, conveyed to Hayes, all of his property excepting out a 330 by 660 portion of land. I believe the intent of the deed was to except out the aliquot portion described as the S1/2 of the NE1/4 of the NE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 17, which would be 660 by 330 in a perfect section. To establish Mr. Tucker's property boundary I base the North, West, and East lines on this aliquot break. Mr. Hayes later transfers title to Sims and Sims transfers a portion of their land to Rasmussen in Microfilm No. MF#130849. That portion is described as a metes and bounds and is plotted accordingly on the map with Sims receiving the remainder. Sims then transfers to Tucker in Microfilm No. MF#132577. I found errors in the break of Section 17 by Survey No. 022-1993. Particularly on the North 1/4, East 1/4, Southeast corner and West 1/16 between Section 17 and 8. These corners were all set by evidence or found. The errors were on the coordinate positions of the corners and do not affect the ground position of the said corners, only the bearings and distances between. I also found errors on the Center 1/4, West 1/4, and South 1/4. In this case the bearings and distances were right but the monuments were set in the wrong position. The errors surfaced when comparing the 1993 GPS survey of Union County with the record information of Survey No. 22-1993. There have been no subsequent surveys based on these monuments and I reset them at the correct positions as shown on page 2 of this survey. Fences are away from the property line as shown. These monuments were set in preparation of a Minor Partition, which was not completed at the request of Mr. Tucker. I am filing this Map of Survey to comply with the 45 day limit regarding monumentation, as set by the Oregon Revised Statutes.


