
Boundary Line Agreement

NARRATIVE

This lot line adjustment was performed at the request of Hans Grage, Helen Tucker, and Keith A. Powelson. The parties listed above wished to monument, post, and boundary line agree to the posted lines as shown on this map of survey. The North line of Section 1, Township 2 North, Range 39 East of the Willamette Meridian was established by Survey No. 14-85. I find the monuments of said survey and base my survey upon these found monuments. The lines to be agreed upon are intended to approximate the record lines and distances of the original lot lines set forth by the Government Survey. All parties are aware that these lines are not based upon a true section break of Section 1, and they are willing to make the posted property their new property lines. We intend to finalize the boundary line agreement with a filed boundary line agreement. I posted the new property line S 0.00'22" E, 707.96 feet to the intersection of the existing right of way fence along the North line of Palmer Junction Road. The most southerly monument is intended to establish the direction of the boundary line between Tucker and Powelson, and does not necessarily mark the most southerly line of their ownership. The existing fences between Ms. Tucker and Mr. Grage and Powelson were set at the top of a steep canyon, and were not intended to mark ownership's and are out of position as shown. I find no other problems with this survey.


