This survey was done at the request of Eldon Foster. The purpose of this survey is to locate the boundaries of the Foster ownership, currently being used as a mobile home park. The exterior of the plat of M.A. Stevenson Addition was originally located by Survey Number 31-72, which located 13th Street for the City of Elgin. Survey Numbers 53-73 and 25-74 also based their positions on this location. Survey Number 150-78 located the interior lines of both M.A.Stevenson Addition and the plat of North Elgin. The remaining surveys listed in the reference material done by 4 different surveying firms have all based their location on the 1978 survey. I also base the location of this property on the 1978 survey. The road along the East line of Block 22 appears to skew West as you move South along the block. This area is currently being studied and some form of road legalization/dedication will probably result from that study. I find the existing mobile homes along the South line of Blocks 21 and 22 encroach onto the street right of way as shown. I find no vacation for Beverly Terrace. The deed calls Mr. Foster's ownership to be all of Blocks 19-22 and the East 60 ft. of Block 18. I find the existing fence and a shed on the adjacent ownership to the East encroaches onto the Foster tract as shown. I can find no dedication for Palmer Street. This portion of the plat of M.A. Stevenson Addition was vacated by Commissioners Journal H, Page 546. The deeds do call courses to the "County Road", with some deeds referring to "Palmer Street". I place the right of way of Palmer Street 30 ft. each side of the existing constructed centerline. The existing fence along the North line of this tract also encroaches onto the Foster ownership. The manager of the mobile home park stated that this fence had recently been moved South, across the creek. The existing fence along the Westerly boundary of this tract fits reasonably well with the location by survey. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.

Solar observation taken at the North quarter corner of Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian.
