

#### NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Anna Canavan on behalf of Railroad Realty. Mrs. Canavan wanted to sell of a strip of the Imbler railroad as shown on the map. The West line of said strip is parallel and offset 150 ft. perpendicular from the Joseph Branch Mainline of Union Pacific Railroad. I rotated Survey No. 41–79 to my basis of bearing and found monuments to fit well with one exception. The monument on the North line set by said Survey is out of position. The cap is missing and I suspect it has been moved. I found a wooden hub occupying the true position. I accepted the position of the hub and ran record bearing of Survey 41–79 on my bearing basis to establish the north line. The east line runs parallel and offset perpendicular 50 ft. to said Mainline until it intersects a line parallel with and 8.50 ft. offset from the westerly spur of the Joseph Branch of Union Pacific Railroad. For the south line I held the record position of Survey No. 41–79. Monuments are away from the true position as shown. I found a building to encroach on the South end of the Survey. The South 1/4 is buried in the middle of a travel lane on the Wallowa Lake Highway. I was unable to occupy said corner and use the record position of Survey No. 20–86. I find no other problems with this survey.




