

This survey was done at the request of Bill Gohring. The purpose of this survey is to monument the exterior of his ownership. I base the location of this survey on survey number 11–84, which located the plat of the Town of the Cove. The remaining surveys listed in the reference material also used the 1984 survey as a basis of their location. All of Block G and additional land to the South was originally one tract of land. Lots 1 and 2 were the first to be sold away from this tract (MF #24961). The next tract to be sold was a portion of Lots 9 and 10, with the South line of the tract being 114 feet South of the South line of Lots 1 and 2 (MF #65361). The next deed was for lands South of Block G (MF #111507). The next transfer was for the "South half of Lots 9 and 10" (MF #147384). There was a deed of trust issued (MF #982511) using the same description as MF #147384. Then the trust deed was foreclosed on, also using the same description. This creates a 2 ft. gap between the property transferred by MF #147384, and MF #65361. I verified this with the title company handling the foreclosure on the tract. I have also made Mr. Gohring aware of the discrepancy. There is also an existing power line crossing the Westerly portion of the tract. This line was granted an easement by MF #104276, however, the grantor had no interest in the property the power line crosses. This was also documented on Minor Partition Plat Numbers 1999–11 and 2000–19. The existing building near the Southwest corner of the tract has had the siding removed since the time of the most recent survey in the area, but the stem wall of the foundation and the framed exterior walls are still in existence. The existing fence lines are still encroaching across the Westerly portion of the Block as shown, and the physical location of the street is shifted East of the true right of way as documented on the previous surveys. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.

BASIS OF BEARING

Solar observation taken at the Southwest corner of Section 15, Township 3 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian.


