

## *NARRATIVE*

This survey was done at the request of Kirk Creech, buyer of the surveyed tract. The West line of this tract is the existing creek, and it's Southerly prolongation, as per deed microfilm number 122912, and documented on survey number 010-1997. The Northerly line of the tract is 180 feet North and parallel with the South line of Section 15 (the centerline of the right of way of Haefer Lane). The East line of the tract is an aliquot line of Section 15. I locate this line as per the subdivision of the Southwest quarter of Section 15 (shown in the detail above left). The tract East of this parcel was surveyed by James G. Voelz in 1962. Mr. Voelz did not properly subdivide the section to locate this line and placed it an even 660 feet East of the Southwest corner of Section 15. I found the "car frame" in concrete set by survey number 13-62, and it reflects the 660 ft. distance. I find the fence along the North line of the tract to be relatively harmonious. I find no unusual conditions on this survey.
