

NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of H. Bruce Stark. The purpose of this survey is to adjust the common boundary line of the Stark ownership, with the McClelland property. I also replaced a pin at the Northwest corner of the Stark ownership that was originally set by survey number 026-1997, but destroyed by gas line construction. All of the tracts within the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 15 were originally transferred by metes and bounds descriptions, beginning at the Southwest quarter of Section 15. The adjacent ownerships to the West half of the Southwest quarter were all originally described aliquotly. I therefore fix the limits of these tracts at the aliquot lines on the East, West and South. The North line was previously placed along an existing fence and documented by the quit claim deed recorded as microfilm number 148834 in the Union County deed records. located the existing fences within this area to try to provide harmony with the existing conditions. I find that the most Westerly and Southerly lines of occupation are the most harmonious, but as the occupation lines move East, they diverge from the true deed lines. The deeds within this area have a combination of calls for the East-West lines. Survey number 140-78 used right angles from the West line of Section 15. Some of the deeds do make this call, however if the right angle method is used, it would cause the East-West lines of occupation encroach an additional 1 1/2 feet along the East lines of these tracts. In order to provide harmony and prevent gaps and overlaps between the ownerships, I place the East-West lines in this area parallel with the South line of Section 15, and the North-South lines parallel with the West line of Section 15. I show the relationship of the existing fences to these lines for the overall tract. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
