


## NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Ken Mandeville. The purpose of this survey is to monument the Mandeville ownership. I base the location of the subdivision of Section 15 on the surveys listed in the reference material. In researching the chain of title for this area, I find the original parent parcels were described as the East and West half of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter. I locate the West line of the Mandeville ownership along the aliquot line as per deed. The tracts North of and the 14 ft. strip East of the Mandeville ownership were transferred by metes and bounds description from the original East half of the said subdivision of Section 15. I locate these adjoining tracts by giving them full measure, as they are senior to the Mandeville tract. The fence lines marking the 14 ft. flag along the East side, fall almost entirely on the Mandeville tract. There is also an Easterly shift along the West line of the tract, with an existing barn encroaching as shown. The fence line along the Northerly portion of the tract does not reflect the jog as called for in the deed. I set reference pins along the South line of the tract along the Northerly right of way line of Antles Lane, which is not coincident with the aliquot line of Section 15 as shown. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
