

NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by John Meek and Lee Insko to mark their common boundaries. Mr. Insko also wished to define his East boundary and his lines that were common with the Reisom Property. base this survey on monuments set by Surveys 14-85, 3-70, 22-2000 and Survey Number 018-2004 for Řeisom Corporation. Leé and Elizabeth Insko acquired the East half of the East half of the Southwest Quarter, and the entire Southeast quarter of Section 36, excepting the North twenty acres of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and excepting the North two rods of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter in deed document 46072. Insko then sold to John and Kristine Bush lands which are now owned by Meek. Meek acquired his property (which was originally sold to Bush) from John and Patricia Fagan, MF 982224, and I find that the Meek East Line matches the calls exactly with the West Line of the remaining Insko property. I break Section 36 in the standard manner, and run the metes and bounds description. I find that Insko acquired all of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 36, EXCEPT the North 20 acres. The conveyance to the REISOM CORPORATION, calls the portion to be the North half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter. I believe that the intent was to convey the North half of the aforementioned property and have divided it on the basis of equal distance from the 1/16 corners. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
