

BASIS OF BEARING

Solar observations taken at a point 780 feet North of the Southwest corner of Section 29, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of the Willamette Meridian.

NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by Blaine Kelly on behalf of Douglas and Victoria Manske. Mr. and Mrs. Manske were intending to build an addition on to the existing house and wanted their property lines marked. I located the centerline of "L" avenue by existing screws set in lead plugs at First and "L" as found by survey Number 42-79, and drive to a found 3/4" pipe, (raised with a 1/2" rebar by Survey Number 29-83) set by Survey Number 18-89, in the centerline of "L" Avenue and Walnut street. Survey Number 29-83 locates the centerline of "L" Avenue and Alder Street at a distance of 299.55' on a bearing of N89°39'00" W, and also located the centerline of Alder Street and "M" Avenue at a distance of 320.01 feet on a bearing of N 0°21'36" E to a found 3/4" pipe set by Survey Number 18-89. I did not open the centerline of Alder and "M" Avenue, as it has just been recently paved with new asphalt. I found the monuments at the corner of Block 6, originally set by Survey Number 109, and also find an unrecorded 5/8 rebar at the Northwest corner of said Block 6. I find the southeast corner of Block 11, and find that the distance between the Southeast corner of Block 11 and the Southwest corner of Block 6 does not measure 80 feet as called. Both monuments were set by the same surveyor in the 1950's. I established the centerline of "M" Avenue and Walnut Street midway between the two monuments, and drive to the found 3/4" pipe at "L" and Walnut, I then establish the corners of Block 12 by parallel lines 40 feet distant from the centerlines of the surrounding streets. I find that there is an existing sanitary sewer main that runs west to east along the South line of this property. I find no easement for this line at the courthouse, nor is there a provision for an easement in the Manske deed. I find that the lines of occupancy fit very well with this survey. I find no unusual conditions with this
