



This survey was ordered by the NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION SERVICE for the purpose of creating a wetland reserve easement on lands owned by Dan and Tracy Davidson. The limits of the wetland easement were defined by the NATURAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION SERVICE, and were marked and tied in place. Sections 22 and 23 were surveyed and monumented by Survey Number 003—2004. The sections were properly broken and I found and accept the existing monuments as shown. The South and East Lines of this wetland easement were also defined by said Survey Number 003-2004. The West line of the easement generally follow an existing fence line, and follow the directions of Dan Davidson. Hunter Road was also defined by the aforementioned survey, and I set one monument along the East line of said road. The easement contains 108.59 acres as monumented. I find that the existing fence line along the North line of this easement actually falls South of the title line along the easterly half of this easement, and gradually drifts across the title line until the fence falls approximately 15 feet to the North of the title line at Hunter Road. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
