

The current deed to the property (MF 20010305) is described by metes and bounds, giving full 60 foot measure to the property, as well as the tract to the South (MF 20084780). The tract to the south is described as the South half of Lots 5 and 6. Tracing the deeds back through the chain of title, it appears as though the original description was the North half of Lots 5 and 6 (Book 143, Page 247), which began to be described both as North half of said lot and block and as a metes and bounds in Book 145, Page 742, eventually containing only the metes and bounds description, as it does today. therefore treat the intent of the conveyance to be the North half of said Lots 5 and 6, Block 9 of Arnold and Dray's Addition. No recorded vacation of the alley in Block 9 could be found. All sources make mention that it was vacated prior to the recording of the plat. I discussed this with Abstract and Title Company, who has insured title to the center of the alley for ownerships within this block. I place my pins on this basis.

Centerline monumentation around the block appears to be removed by construction. I establish the centerline of Third Street from the found pin set by Survey 002-2007 by running record bearing and distance North along the East right of way of Third St. From the centerline of 4th Street and 'G' Avenue, I run a record bearing, as per Survey 24-85, West to establish the Third Street and 'G' Ave. intersection. From there I run record bearing and distance around the block as per Survey Number 11-87. There appears to be a scrivener error on said survey in the bearing of 'F' Avenue. The intent appears to be "N 89°39'45" W", and not 'N 89°38'45" W'. This allows for proper closure of the block and maintains a consistent angular relationship between 2nd Street and F Avenue centerlines when compared to other surveys in the area. I find the pin along F Avenue set by Survey 11-87 to be in good condition, though the one along Third Street appears to be disturbed and is out of position as noted. A half inch rebar at the NE corner of the tract, pointed out by the client, occupies the true corner position, though there does not appear to be any record of it. The majority of a small metal shed encroaches onto the North side of the property and the fences on that boundary deviate from the property line as shown on the map. Fences along the West and South side are on the property line.

I see no other unusual conditions with this survey.




