Plat of Pleasant Home Addition to La Grande (1903)

This survey was done at the request of Mildred Vogan, owner of the land within. Ms. Vogan wanted the exteriors of her property monumented. The Spruce Street right of way was placed by the lead plugs referencing the original Mclain monuments. The intersection monuments of Y Avenue and Maple and Pine Streets were established by Survey Number 021–1997. I place the alignment of X Avenue by record bearing and distance as per Survey Number 22–82. Intersection monuments along Cherry St. appear to have been removed. I place the intersection of Cherry St. and X Ave by said Survey 22–82. I then establish the alignment of Cherry Street by the found pin at the NE corner of Lot 26, set by James Voelz in Survey Number 48–74. I establish the Y avenue alignment East of the intersection of Y Avenue and Pine Street by the pins set by Survey Number 97–77. By establishing it in this manner, the intersection of Y Ave and Cherry St. is relatively harmonious with said surveys.

As pointed out by Survey Number 72-80, the Y Avenue right of way was originally platted in Pleasant Home (1903) as a 41.5 foot right of way. The plat of Sugar Addition, the Mclain 1922 monumentation and other subsequent surveys appear to use a 40 foot right of way width. I can find no vacation on this road and therefore use a 41.5 foot right of way.

The house on the property sits 3.2 feet into the Cherry Street right of way. A shed also encroaches as shown. There is a fenceline encroachment on the West property line, from 4 feet at the North end tapering to 1.7 feet at the South. A lean—to also encroaches as shown on the map. An overhead powerline that runs down the alley falls on property as shown.

I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
