

## NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to find or set corner monuments that were set for Union County Survey No. 018-2005 by Gregory Blackman of Bagett, Griffith & Blackman (BGB) for the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), Ron and Nancy Dake, and Gerald Unger. That BGB survey depicted the boundary of the Wetlands Reserve Program (WRP) Easement No. 66-0436-5-017 that was recorded in Document #20062158, Union County Book of Records. The contract also stated that we place additional line monuments where the distance between the previous corner monuments exceeded 500 feet. We also were to place a green steel "U" shaped fence post with a "Conservation Easement Boundary" sign were placed at each

The field work for this survey was done in conjunction with two other adjacent WRP Easement surveys to the North of this survey. One for Joel Rice (#66-0436-3-040) per SN 003-2004, and the other for Dan & Tracy Davidson (#66-0436-5-016) per SN 023-2005.
