

NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Stefani Mosby, owner of the land within. Mrs. Mosby wanted the exterior of the her ownership marked. The West and North line were placed by Survey Number 020–2000. I use the section break for Section 17 as per Survey Number 006–2009, which differs slightly from the break used in Survey Number 020–2000. I note the differing position in monuments as shown. The 12th Street right of way was placed as per Survey Number 026–2009 and 029–2010. There is a fenceline encroachment along the South line of the property of 6 feet at the West end to about 4.7 feet on the East end. As requested by the client, a witness corner was set on the client's side of the fence at the Southwest corner. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
