I find that the bearing and distance from the fence corners located at the E 1/16th position between Section 30 and 31 and the North 1/16th between Sections 31 and 32 are very harmonious with the Kimbrell Old Book Survey (Pg. 7). I therefore accept these positions as the best available evidence of the original corner positions, and take this method of placing these corners over a potentially extensive double proportion. Internal 1/16th corners within Section 31, however, do not match the Kimbrell survey as well and there is evidence of reconstruction of these fencelines. I place the East quarter corner by single proportion from the N 1/16th corner based on the distances in Old Book Pg 7. I place the East quarter corner and the South 1/16th by single proportion. I further subdivide the section as per BLM Manual of proportions 2009. Placement of the right of way was done by the found brass cap at Station 972+02.11, as per ODOT Strip Map 6B-19-2. The alignment was rotated to the South quarter corner of Section 31.

I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
