## NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Norm Paullus, Public Works Director for the City of La Grande. Mr. Paullus wanted the centerline intersection monuments along Balm Avenue replaced following a paving project. I recovered the 3/4" iron pipe monuments and tie them prior to paving. I set the new monuments at these tied positions. I find no unusual conditions with this survey.
