NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Patrick Marolla on behalf of Hancock Forest Management, land manager for the land within. Mr. Marolla wanted the selected lines in Section 12 monumented and posted prior to a timber harvest. I recover the monuments as shown hereon. Subdivision of the section is as per BLM Manual of Instruction 2009. At the East end of the surveyed line, the deeds call to "a certain rock placed by R.V. Davis and Abel E. Eaton" at a point East 20 rods, more or less, from the NE 1/16th corner. The original deed that created this tract was in Book 52, Page 248, from Abel E. Eaton to R.V. Davis in 1910. With no description of the stone, I rely on lines of possession for placement of this corner. Adjacent landowner, Scotty Baker attested that the fence corner has been in its current position as long as he has owned it (1964). I can find no remaining physical evidence to the contrary. Although the distance discrepancy is gross, I find the position to be acceptable due to the commencement point being an unsurveyed interior sixteenth corner. I hold the position of the rock jack fence corner and slide it Northerly to intersect the aliquot line. Fencelines are off as shown hereon. A logging road that services the Hancock property falls South of the property line. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.

BASIS OF BEARING

True Geodetic North at the corner common to Sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, Township 4 South, Range 41 East of the Willamette Meridian as determined by GPS observation (NAD-83 (1991) datum) as per Survey Number 030-2014
