NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Jeff Watkins, representing the estate of Alan Hall. I base the location of this ownership on the survey monuments found as shown. The Southerly portion of the Hall ownership was located by survey number 9-79. Mr. Hall's South line is called along the County Road. At the time of the 1979 survey, the road was not placed or dedicated. Survey Number 005-2006 documented a legalization of the road at a 30 ft. width. I monument the South line of the Hall tract at the legalized right of way. I find an encroachment of a gravel driveway near the Southwest corner of the Hall ownership as shown. The fence encroachment along the Southeasterly portion of the Hall tract shown on survey 9-79 has been changed, as the existing fence at the time of this survey more closely follows the surveyed line. At the Northeast corner of the Hall tract, I find a 1/2" iron pipe that I assume was set by the plat of Crisman's Addition. No monument is specified, but the location indicates it may have come from the plat. I show two easement locations called for in deed volume 149 page 683 which two sheds encroach upon. I also show the water line location as per the City of La Grande records, which does not follow the deeded easement. The Northwest corner of the Hall tract falls in a drainage on a large boulder. I set a reference pin East of the true position as shown. There is also a small yard area near the Northeast corner of the 37 ft. wide adjoining tract that is within the Hall ownership, but occupied by the adjoining owner to the North. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
