

NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Lee Insko, owner of the land within. Mr. Insko wanted select corners set marking the exterior of his ownership. I find and accept the positions of the section and quarter corners as shown hereon. At the South quarter corner position, Survey 49-71, set a reference pin on the East side of the road. The survey is quite vague with respect to the methodology of how it was established, however it appears harmonious in bearing and appears to have been honored as a property corner by adjacent landowners. Road petition number 667 was originally described as headed North through this quarter corner. The road survey by the county engineer's department for this petition shows a 'stake' occupying the position of the quarter corner. The centerline of the built road is harmonious in distance with the sections corners to the East and West. I therefore place the quarter corner by driving a line from pin at the Southeast corner of Section 25 through the previously mentioned pin set by 49-71 (along the East side of the road) to the centerline of the constructed Palmer Junction Road. I find this position harmonious with the fence on the West side of the road as well. At the time of this survey, the road is slated for reconstruction, so only a spindle was set at the true position and rebar references taken. Monumentation sheet is filed separately. Subdivision of the section is as per BLM Manual of Instructions.

I place the Palmer Junction Road right of way as per USDOT right of way map fitting the alignment to the constructed road. Within Section 25, Moses Creek Lane was petitioned along the East/West center of section line (Petition #702). I place the centerline along the aliquot line. Pins falling along the right of way were set on the right of way line.

I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
