NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Fred Alexis. The purpose of this survey is to monument and mark with steel fence posts the North line of the Alexis ownership. The tracts East of Partition Plat Number 20060004T are described by a mix of aliquot and metes and bounds calls. Most all of the descriptions call the East-West dimension 80 rods while calling the East and West lines aliquot. The North-South dimension on most tracts is called 20 rods, with Deed Volume 31 Page 171, Deed Volume 41 Page 264 and Microfilm Number 133497 calling the division lines on the aliquot line. By these calls, I believe the intent is to transfer these tracts along the aliquot lines. I place this line as such and as called in Deed Volume 31 Page 171. I set steel fence posts along this line as shown. The existing fence line falls approximately 4 feet South of the aliquot line in this area. I discussed this with the adjoining owner to the North, who was concerned about the improvements along this line. There are no encroachments other than the existing fence line. I place the monument near the Easterly terminus of the property line at a point 30 feet West of the physical centerline of Mt. Glen Road. I find no other unusual conditions on this survey.
