
NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Kyle Martin, on behalf of Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, Ladd Marsh, owner of the land within. Mr. Martin wanted the exterior of their ownership monumented and posted. I recover the monuments as shown hereon. I subdivide the section as per BLM Manual of Instructions 2009.

The North half of Section 3, South of Foothill Road, was at one time owned in its entirely by the State of Oregon (Book 150, Page 62). They conveyed the property to the South of the fenceline in by Book 151, Page 72 and it appears to conveyed based on the courses of Survey number 24–65. Though I find no monuments from Survey 24–65, I find the existing fenceline to be relatively harmonious with the courses of said survey. I do a best fit rotation, based on the record courses, to match the basis of bearing of Survey Number 24–65. Though the deed calls to the portion falling within the Northeast quarter, since the entirely was owned by the State of Oregon, and the conveyance was based on survey, I have departed from the aliquot line in the North half of Section 3 and drive a line from the Center quarter corner to the pin 1139.8 feet South of the North quarter corner.

The remainder is subdivided as per BLM Manual of Instructions 2009. I find fences within Section 4 to conform very well in portions except on the East line of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, where it appears to be a fenceline of convenience along an existing road. Fencelines are off as shown hereon. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
