
NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Patrick Marolla, on behalf of Hancock Forest Management, land manager for the land within. Mr. Marolla wanted select ownership lines monumented and posted. I recover the monuments as shown and accept them in place. I find a fence corner at the West quarter of Section 1 within 7 ft. of a proportioned position. Though this appears to be of more recent construction, it appears to be replacing a more ancient fenceline, as evidenced by found wire buried in rotting tree stumps. Estimated age of old fenceline is in excess of sixty years. I accept this as as the best available evidence of the original corner position. I make a diligent effort to find remaining evidence of the Southwest Section corner and South quarter of said Section but find nothing. This area has seen extensive logging. I replace these corners at proportioned position. Section is subdivided as per BLM Manual of Instruction 2009.

Palmer Junction Road was established by Road Petition 412. I accept the location of the road as constructed. The county acquired more right of way by quitclaim deed recorded in Microfilm Number 113662. This area is specifically excepted from title on the Hancock deed. I rotate the deed calls to my basis of bearing and find it fall very harmoniously with the existing centerline.

Fencelines are off as shown. Property line runs through a rock pit along the East side of the property. I find no unusual conditions with this survey.
