

NARRATIVE

This survey was done at the request of Andy Campo, contract purchaser of the land within. Mr. Campo wanted to monument the exteriors of this property. The land comprising this property, as well as the property to the South was surveyed by James Voelz in Survey Number 28–73. Though many of these monuments have been removed by road construction, these position were perpetuated by monumentation recovery surveys 045–2003 and 002–2011. The remaining monument is at the Southeast corner of the lot, as it was configured at the time of the 1973 survey. Survey Number 026–2016 as well as 027–2018 place the NW corner of this survey at a point 319.50 feet from the NW corner of Block 68 of Hindman's Addition. I find monuments within this block to be harmonious with each other and with record distances of the deed calls. Deeds do not have any gaps or overlaps requiring junior/senior rights analysis. Based on Survey 012–2020, as it runs by this property there is about a 0.22 ft. difference in the 'WE' centerline alignment and the 'D' line alignment of the centerline of Division Street. The centerline of Division, as placed hereon falls between the two, falling 0.13 ft South of the 'WE' line and 0.09 ft North of the 'D' line. The acquisition of the NW corner of the property by MF 20151082 calls for a width of 40.35 feet tapering to 30.31 ft (metric equivalent) based on the 'WE' centerline, which leaves a 0.18 foot jog. Due to its proximity, I do not monument the South portion of this jog. The building on the South line of the property falls South of line by approx. 0.25–0.36 ft. Portions of the structural support columns and concrete bases for the air vents of the building to the East fall 0.6 – 1.25 feet West of the property line. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.




