#### *NARRATIVE*

This survey was done at the request of Brian Kruse, owner of the parent parcel of this lot line adjustment. Mr. Kruse wanted to adjust the line as shown. Deeds in the area North of Sterling's Second Addition commence at points from lot corners in said subdivision. Survey 39–65 initially monumented the ownerships in this area, and subsequent surveys have generally adhered to the methods of said survey. Survey 055–1998 later placed Blocks within Sterling's Second Addition by retracement of Survey 006–1993. There is an approximate 4 foot difference in Easting between the two surveys.

As most deeds in this area appear to be based on the earlier 1965 survey, I hold pins that are based on Survey 35–65. Survey 16–88 appears to place the South line of Railroad Ave by holding constant line from the North line of 9–88. In fact the deed records indicate a 2 foot jog at the West end of Survey 9–88. The position of the monument set by Survey 16–88 does curiously seem to account for this jog despite not showing it on the map. I surmise that this is an omission on the survey. I recreate the position of the NW corner of Lot 3, Block 23 as placed by Survey 39–65 by running record bearing and distance as per Survey 16–88. This puts the location 4 feet East and 0.7 ft South of the pin set by Survey 055–1998. This survey indicates that the pin fell North and West, however, reviewing the internal records of that survey, I believe this the directions are backwards. I therefore hold this point as the commencement point for Deed 154, Page 641 and run record distances in order to place the West line of the parcels involved in this lot line adjustment. All remaining lines I run record distance holding the lines parallel with the South line of Record Street and the West line of Survey 9–88. For the true South line of the In Him tract, I hold the North line of Sterling's Second Addition as placed by Survey 055–1998. Due to the discrepancy in the location of block corners of Sterling's Second Addition, the legal descriptions prepared for this adjustment utilize the quarter corner as a commencement point.

I place the new line at the direction of the landowners. I find no other unusual conditions with this survey.
