UNION COUNTY ROAD PETITIONS

INTRODUCTION

County Roads within Union County have historically been created by a combination of Petitions, Court Documents, Road Deeds, and Commissioner's actions recorded in Commissioner Journals. Historically these have been poorly organized and difficult to research. This GIS is an attempt to make these entries more accessible to the public.

DISCLAIMER

Due to the difficulty in placing many petitions and journal entries, due to either poorly written or incomplete legal descriptions, this GIS is in no way a complete accounting of all road documents within the county. Some records are appropriations for gravel and others are not in the bounds of Union County. A list of petitions that are not included or are placed in an approximate manner in this GIS are included at this link.



Road records, even at their best, were often poorly described, and though every attempt to place the road within the proper quarter-quarter section has been made, there is the potential for nonexact placement. It therefore recommended that in researching a road, users should utilize a wide berth, to ensure that all records pertaining to an area are included.

INSTRUCTIONS

The road records are organized by quarter-quarter sections, each one of these 40's which will have a hyperlink to the road document. Clicking 'More info' will take you to the scanned documents. In the event that multiple road records intersect, there will a "(1 of #) at the top of the popup window. Hitting the right of left arrow in the upper right hand corner of the popup window will allow you to scroll through the records.
